Plane Pull

Our 3rd annual Plane Pull is taking place Saturday, June 4, 2016 and there's still time to sign up!

Teams of up to 20 people will test their strength against a UPS 757 airplane that weighs more than 120,000 pounds. The teams will compete to see who can pull the airplane 12 feet in the fastest time. For the first time ever, teams will get to pull twice, with their fastest time counting as their final time. Both pulls will be consecutive. Teams can enter into one of seven categories.
