We had 12 foursomes for this event that enjoyed a day of golf, lunch and awards dinner. A big thanks to Price Chopper for joining our team and Lynn Clayton for all of his support!
- LETR Truck Convoy –HONK! HONK! The World's Largest Truck Convoy took place Saturday, October 8. 116 trucks participated in the convoy this year and we raised a record \$38,000 for Special Olympics Iowa.
