## **Special Olympics Iowa Program Report**

## February 16, 2018

This report presents current numbers in SOIA Programs as of February 16, 2018. It will review participation numbers in all events from 11/1/17 through 2/17/18 that come from the Census Report that Tanner Nissen develops and maintains (page 2). In 2017 SOIA provided 100 Program events to our delegations and athletes. We introduced the new SOIA Release and Medical Form and Teri Barthelmes has processed 801 completed forms since the rollout September 15. Wendy Olinger has arranged through the SOIA Healthy Athlete Initiative to provide free physical exams at the Mid-Winter Tournament and Summer Games for athletes that have expired or soon to be expired physicals. The Unified Program, under the direction of Bryan Coffey, is growing and we now have 40 Unified Championship Schools and one SO College (University of Iowa).

In the additional documents you will see the breakdown of Class A credentials, new delegations and new athletes that have been processed by Sally Briggs (page 3). The last document (page 4) shows the number of coaches that have completed online coach trainings and in person coach trainings from 11/14/17 to 2/16/18. Katie Rasmussen and Erin Birkenholtz are doing a great job in their outreach services in recruiting new delegations, coaches and athletes. They are also creating positive experiences for the delegations as they deal with issues in fundraising, finding volunteers and support at the local level.

Elin Phipps and Stephanie Kocer have revamped our "Volunteer Page" on the <a href="www.soiowa.org">www.soiowa.org</a> website and have simplified the process for volunteers to register for SOIA events. Now, by clicking on the "Volunteer" link, the volunteer will be directed to a page that shows details for each of our upcoming Program events and if the individual event is open for volunteer registration. I am sure that our volunteers will find this to be a very convenient tool as they look to be involved in the SOIA Program events.

All Area Directors are preparing for the Area Spring Games, which are qualification events for the Summer Games. All Area Spring Games will be completed by April 14 and the deadline for Summer Games registration is April 16.
