- Coordinate and supervise all aspects of the Law Enforcement Torch Run
- Work with the Volunteer Torch Run Director and State Torch Run Committee
- Work to involve more law enforcement departments in the Torch Run
- Represent Iowa LETR at regional and national meetings
- Actively recruit volunteers for LETR and other SOIA events
- Seek and obtain sponsorships
- Develop and maintain supporter relationships
- Train and Supervise the Torch Run Event Coordinator
- Oversee and supervise other LETR events including Cargill Night, Swing with the Celebrities and Jim Jordan Golf Tournament
- Oversee and supervise all Polar Plunges, LETR related or not
- Develop new sources of funding and expand or improve existing sources
- Ability to travel throughout the state, including some evenings and weekends
