Types of Volunteers

Day of Event Volunteers:

Volunteers who show up the day of the event and are assigned a position such as score keeping, ball retrieving, timing, awards assistant, souvenir sales, escort, etc. (Day of event volunteers are not required to have a Class A Certification)

Other Volunteers:

Coaches, event managers, area directors, event committee members, officials, referees, photographers, first aid, medical professionals, chaperones, fundraising volunteers. Contact us!

Class A Volunteer Certification:

Volunteers who have direct contact with athletes; is in a position of authority/ supervision of athletes; or handles money for SOIA.
