

Event Policy on Non-Essential Wheeled Devices

To ensure a safe and accessible environment for all attendees, the use of **non-essential wheeled devices** is prohibited during all official Special Olympics Iowa events and activities. This includes both indoor and outdoor event spaces.

Prohibited Devices Include, but are not limited to:

- [Electric] scooters
- Skateboards
- Hoverboards
- Bicycles
- Roller skates and rollerblades
- Any other similar personal transport devices not used as mobility aids

Mobility Aid Exception:

This policy does not apply to medically necessary mobility aids, including but not limited to:

- Manual or electric wheelchairs
- Walkers
- Canes and crutches

Attendees using mobility aids are welcome and encouraged to notify event staff in advance if any accommodations are needed.

Enforcement:

Event staff reserve the right to ask attendees to remove or store any non-essential wheeled devices during the event. Failure to comply may result in removal from event areas.
